Subject: Visual Art

Date: 2/23/2024

Topic: Generative AI for Image Creation

Lesson # AI.2

Lesson Focus and Goals: Building Prompts for better image creation. Using content specific language to get the image that they expect.

Materials Needed: Access to an image generator such as Adobe Express, Adobe Firefly, or Adobe Photoshop. Column printable & list of image characteristics for refining prompts.

Learning Objectives & Standards:
Anchor Standard: 1: Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work
Anchor Standard: 7: Perceive and analyze artistic work

Structure / Activity:

Students can work independently or in groups.

1. **Instructions:** Fill out the column printable.
2. **Use** the column printable to come up with a string of words for a visual prompt.
3. **Next, create that image in your image generator** (Photoshop, Firefly, etc.), on a page that is 8" x 8" (select the entire artboard and type your prompt into the generative fill, Choose one of the first three images options, export it as a .jpg and put it on that page of the slide show.
4. Create 3-5 images.
5. **Images could be printed or placed on a slide presentation or blog or web post.**
6. **Next share your images & Discuss or write.** Explain how the images were closer to your expectations (or not) than the the images in the High 5 Exercise. Did these images meet your expectations why/why not?

Assessment: Check for understanding by viewing images, written work, or discussions.
